Parking

If you collect during the Southway School arrival and departure times you will be required to show a Stepping Stones Car Park Pass. These are Yellow and available from the office.

Does your child attend another setting?

Please let us know if your child attends another registered childcare setting including childminders. With your permission we like to share your child's latest 'moving forward form' with them and encourage them to do the same, so that we can gain a full picture of their learning and development.

A polite reminder – Please remember to let us know if any of your personal details change such as phone numbers, address etc so that we can keep your child's records up to date.



Exclusions for common childhooa illnesses

Please don't forget that the following illnesses have these exclusions:

<u>Diarrhoea and vomiting-</u> 48 hours from the last episode

<u>Conjunctivitis</u>- 48 hours from start of treatment

<u>Chicken Pox-</u> 5 days from the onset of rash, providing spots are dry and healed

Hand, foot and mouth-48 hours from onset of rash, providing children are well and the child's mouth is not causing them discomfort
